

JOB DESCRIPTION FOR POSITION OF BOWRAL CHURCH OF CHRIST PASTOR

Role responsibilities:

The Pastor is required to work alongside the church Leadership. Together they will develop strategies, and oversee ministries and programs that facilitate discipleship, outreach, pastoral care and connections, with an emphasis on children and youth.

The Pastor is responsible for undertaking general ministry tasks such as preaching, service co-ordination, funerals, weddings and pastoral care.

Personal Qualities

- A strong sense of God's calling to pastoral leadership.

- Be a citizen or permanent resident of Australia
